Shipwreck Rules Sheet

Teams will be selected at random in ABCD format

Tee's: Players will play from their standard Men's Club Tees

Handicap: Players will receive 100% of their handicap allocated to the lowest handicap holes based upon the tees they are playing

Event Format

All players will play their own ball through the hole. The team score will consist of the two low net scores combined on the first 6 holes (holes 1 thru 6), three low net combined on the next 6 holes (holes 7 thru 12) and all four net scores combined on the final 6 holes (holes 13-18).

Skins

Skins will be individual Gross/Net skins. Skins pot is \$10 per player

Rule Additions/ Changes to Standard Men's Club Event Rules specific to this event

In the event a team is required to play the entire event with three players a blind draw partner will be provided. Both the players and blind draw player shall participate in payouts. In the event a player cannot finish a round due to injury, illness or emergency the team will just play a person down counting the remaining scores except when the missing player is a required score. A Net bogey should be recorded in that instance.
