2010 Women's Club Fees

Membership Packages:

- 1) \$55 Basic Membership (incl USGA Handicap)
- 2) \$100 Basic (incl USGA Handicap) and all Weekly Events

Optional Events:

- 1) Doubles Match Play – Additional \$10
- 2) Match Play – Additional \$10
- 3) Ringer Board – Additional \$10
- 4) Weekly Event – \$5 Additional per event if you choose
Membership package 1 (included in membership pkg 2)
- 5) Team Play – Additional \$5

Dues must be paid by the first day of league play, May 4. If you do not have an established handicap, please try to play five 18-hole rounds before league officially starts on May 4.

Make your check payable to Pebble Creek Women's Club. Indicate if you are registering for the 9 hole or 18 hole club, and mail to:

If you choose Package #1, you may elect to play in any of the weekly events for \$5 per event (some 9-hole weeks may be more). When you check in with the Pro Shop, indicate to them that you would like to play in the event of the day and pay the fee. Money will be paid out to the winners of that event in the form of credit in the Pro Shop. Winners will be posted on the bulletin board and the website.

Additional fees will be assessed throughout the season for participation in optional events such as Guest Day and Fall Scramble. Check the Calendar of events for dates and events. Information regarding cost and time for these special events will be available closer to the event's date. Check the Women's Club bulletin board for information and sign-up sheets.

Team Play

Optional Event (\$5) - Members will be assigned to a 3 to 5 person team (depending on how many sign up to participate) with an A-B-C-D-E level player on each team. You will play your regular Tuesday round (**play with whoever you want to, you don't have to play with team members**) and your scores will be combined and/or points earned and tracked for each team. Prizes for top teams will be awarded at the Fall Banquet!

Match Play

Optional Event (\$10) for all levels of play. Match Play sets one player against another, rather than one player against a field as in stroke play. Opponents compete to win individual holes, and the player who wins the most holes wins the match.

We will have singles and doubles Match Play groups this year – playing both 9 holes 18 holes (divided into handicap divisions if enough members sign up). You can participate in any group – regardless of which league you play in on Tuesdays. You need to have a USGA handicap established by May 31st to participate.

Match Play requires only a \$10 fee for each division you play in. Prizes will be awarded from this money at the end of the season to the Match Play winner and runner up (for each league and within each handicap division, if used). **Match Play is double elimination – so everyone is guaranteed two matches!** You must sign up by May 8.

Birdie Tree and Par Tree

All members can participate in Birdie Tree and/or Par Tree by posting any qualifying natural birdies, natural pars or natural eagles from a qualifying round from Tuesday club play or any sponsored Women's Club activity.

The membership will be divided in two groups for 2010– the group with the higher handicaps will participate in the Par Tree-- and should post any natural pars. (Any natural birdie from someone in this group should also be posted on the Birdie Tree). The group with the lower handicaps is eligible to participate in the Birdie Tree, and should post any natural birdies. **ALL** members should post any natural eagles they get in the designed "Eagles Nest". (The groups are defined on the Par Tree and Birdie Tree posters located in the Ladies Locker Room.)

The Women's Club Board has approved \$4 of each member's fees to be used for the Par Tree/Birdie Tree fund this year. Awards will be given at the end of the season – the payout allocation will take into account a member's opportunity to play and other factors (to make it as fair as possible for all members) and the payout approach will be approved by the Board. Additionally, monthly recognition will be given for all qualifying Pars, Birdies or Eagles posted! Look for these postings in the Ladies Locker Room!

- April 20 **Spring Banquet**
- April 27 **Golf Clinic – 5:30 - Range**
- May 4 **Spring Scramble – 5:30 Shotgun**
- May 11 **Least Putts** - Record all putts; least amount wins
- May 18 **Best Poker Hand** - Using scores from each hole, make your best five card poker hand.
- May 25 **Survivor**– Survivor challenges distributed on the day of the event.
- June 1 **Flag Day**
- June 8 **Blind Holes** – Scores count on certain unannounced holes.
- June 15 **ONE S** – Count scores on the holes that begin with o, n, e, s. (1,6,7,8,9 – 9 hole and 11,16,17,18 – 18 hole)

- July 27 **Substitute Par** - after play, select 2 holes (9 hole) that you substitute with a par score (18 hole player select 2 holes per 9).
- Aug 3 **Aces Wild** – Record all 1 putts
- Aug 10 **Pebble Creek Points** – Double Bogey – 1, Bogey-2 pt, Par-3 pts, Birdie – 4 pts, Eagle – 5 pts.
- Aug 18 **9-Hole Club Championship (1st round)**
18-Hole Low Net

Ringer Board

Optional Event (\$10) – This is a fun way to track your improvement per hole during the season. The first time you play a set of 9 holes, write your gross score (not adjusted score) for that hole on the Ringer Board in the locker room. Throughout the season as you improve your score for that hole **during Tuesday play**, write down the lower score. Points are earned for improvement and prizes are awarded at the Fall Banquet.

Handicaps

Remember to adjust your score before entering it into the computer which is located in the bar area of the Clubhouse. (You may also post your score online @ GHIN.com.) If you play other courses, please enter those adjusted scores also, so your handicap will remain accurate.

9 Hole members should enter their adjusted 9 hole score. The computer will match another score with it to complete an 18 hole round.

TUESDAY IS WOMEN'S GOLF DAY

All Women's Club events, tournaments, and banquets, will be held on Tuesdays. Women's Club begins Tuesday, May 4 and is played rain or shine. If the weather is questionable, call the Pro Shop to ask if it has been cancelled.

9 Hole – Tee Times begin at 4:30

18 Hole – Tee Times begin at 9:00 AM and again at 2:30 PM

Please check in 15 minutes prior to your tee time!

IMPORTANT: You must golf with at least one other club member to qualify for club and weekly events.

Sign-up sheets will be available in the Pro Shop one week prior to play. The sign-up deadline for each week will be the Sunday preceding each Tuesday. Any unused tee times will be released and made available to the public as of Monday morning. If you need to cancel, please call the Pro Shop at least 24 hours prior to your scheduled tee time.

WHEN PLAY IS COMPLETED

Check your scorecard for the following information:

- 1) First and last name
- 2) Date
- 3) Two signatures verifying scores

Remember to adjust your score before recording your handicap in the computer or online (GHIN.com).

Please turn in all scorecards to the Pro Shop. (If you pick up your ball or do not completely finish any hole during your round, you are disqualified from that weekly event.)

Pebble Creek Golf Course Local Rules

Natural Areas (i.e., wild flowers, #1 Blue) **WILL BE** considered

PLAYABLE unless otherwise posted with signs. If signs are posted, you may take a free drop, nearest point of relief plus a club length, but no closer to the hole (no penalty).

Obstructions, Buildings – If you are within 30 feet of a pump house (i.e., #9 Blue) or shelter and the structure is in your line of flight to the green, you may move laterally (sideways) to the nearest point of relief from the building and drop ball within one club length of that spot (no penalty).

Drop Areas – Drop areas are identified with a white circle or drop area sign. Due to improvements around the course, there may be other drop areas during this golf season. Please ask if you are not sure about a situation.

GPS/Range Finder Use – The Pebble Creek Women's Club has adopted a local rule, in accordance with USGA guidelines, to allow the use of GPS/Range Finders during all Women's Club activities. Only the distance feature may be used; you are not allowed to use the slope feature if your device has such a function. In addition, if you do not have a range finder and your playing partner does, it is permissible under USGA rules to ask the range finder owner for measurements of your shots, too. Keep in mind, however, that your playing partner does not have to oblige.
