Ringer Board

The ringer board is a fun way to track your improvement per hole during the golf season. The first time you play a set of 9 holes, you write the score for that hole on the Ringer Board. Throughout the season as you improve your score for that hole during Tuesday play, you write the lower score down. Points are earned for improvement and prizes are awarded at the fall banquet!

Match Play

Match Play is a competitive activity and all levels of play are welcome. We will have two Match Play groups – one playing 9 holes and one playing 18 holes. You can sign up for either 9 or 18 holes – irregardless of which group you play in on Tuesdays. You need to have a USGA handicap established by May 31st to participate. We also have doubles match play, rules are the same as above, sign up with a friend or as a single and we will find a partner for you.

In Match Play, you will compete against one other individual (net scores are used) – brackets for the initial round will be established by early June and who plays who will be randomly assigned. You set up your own tee times and can play any day of the week within a two-week time frame per round. It is double elimination, so you are guaranteed 2 rounds of play. It is a great way to improve your golf game and meet new people!

Team Play - Competitive "League"

We have a competitive "league" or team play for interested Women's Club members. Ladies will be assigned to a 4-person team at the beginning of the season – with an A-B-C-D level player on each team. You will play your regular Tuesday round (**you do not have to play with your team members**) – and your scores will be combined and/or points earned and tracked for each team. The team with the best score/most points will be recognized at the Fall Banquet!
