



SENIOR CLUB CHAMPIONSHIP

Saturday, July 22nd - Sunday, July 23rd

The Men's Senior Club Championship will play 18 holes on Saturday and 18 holes on Sunday from the regular Men's Club tees. Format is individual stroke play using full handicaps. Any Men's Club member age 50 or over, is in good standing and has posted a minimum of 3 scores in men's club events during the current season qualifies for this event. **TEE TIMES Start at 11:00 AM Saturday & 11:00 AM Sunday.**

The Senior Club Champion will be the 50+ year old player who shoots the **best 36-hole Gross score** from the member tees

**Event Fee: Full Member \$20 plus \$20 cash for skins
Ala Carte Member \$30 plus \$20 cash for skins**

Sr. Club Championship Rules

Individual Stroke Play – 36 Holes

Tee's: Players will play from their standard Men's Club Tees. Only players playing from the Member Tees are eligible to win the Gross Sr. Club Champion. If a Senior that typically plays from the Silver or Combo Tees would like to compete for the Sr. Club Champion they need to indicate they would like to move back to the Member tees for this event.

Handicap: Players will receive 100% of their handicap allocated to the lowest handicap holes based upon the tees they are playing

Event Format

All players will play their own ball through the hole. Players will be flighted by handicap. All flights will be net

The Sr. Club Champion will be the lowest Gross Score over 36 Holes from the Member Tees.

Skins

Skins will be individual Gross/Net skins. Skins pot is \$10 per player per day

Rule Additions/ Changes to Standard Men's Club Event Rules specific to this event

In the event of a tie for the overall Gross Sr. Champion, all players tied will play sudden death starting on the hole of the tournament chairperson's designation. First player to post the lowest score is the Sr. Club Champion. All flights will follow standard tie breaking procedures.

In the event weather does not allow the round to be safely played both days the tournament will be shortened to the last number of competed holes by every group.

Sr. Club Championship is a major event. To be qualified to play in Sr. Club Championship the player must be a member in good standing, be 50 or over and have posted a minimum of three prior scores in a previous Men's Club event during the current season. This would include leagues, weekend events, Summer Series, Individual or 2 Man Match Play, 16 Man, Sr. 8 man and the Men's/ Women's Club social. Pro shop or other MPGA events do not count toward the 3 events.
